- Cook food for the sick and for funerals as needed (LuAnn Barton)
- Provide "as needed" transportation to transport people to doctor's appointments, church, etc.
- Assist with baby showers and bridal showers
- Visit members in hospitals or shut-in
- Take communion to shut-ins on a rotating schedule

Missions (Chuck Duncan)

- Serve on the mission committee
- Go on mission trips

Outreach

- Visit new or perspective members
- Invite new or perspective members to a fellowship meal
- Make phone call follow ups to new visitors

Celebrate Recovery (Wister Basden)

- Set up on Sundays after morning assembly
- Help prepare and serve meal
- Set up desserts and clean up
- Set up afterwards for Wednesday class
- Worship team (must read music)

Miscellaneous

- Project management
- Organizing (i.e. library, storage spaces, etc.)
- Prepare bulletin when secretary is absent
- Answer phone in church office occasionally when needed
